

# KitchenAid KSM150PSER Power Cord Replacement

#### **INTRODUCTION**

If your device is not turning on, it may be the result of a faulty power cord. This guide demonstrates how to replace it.



# **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #2 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)

#### Step 1 — Power Cord





- Using a Phillips #2 screwdriver, remove the 10mm screw on the back cover by rotating it counterclockwise.
- The back cover is now free. Remove it by pulling back and up on the cover.

## Step 2





- Using a Phillips #2 screwdriver, remove the 5mm screws holding the trimband to the top housing by rotating them counterclockwise.
- Pull the trimband off the housing by grabbing each side and pulling it off the front.


## Step 3





- Using a Phillips #2 screwdriver, remove the 12mm screw holding the grounding wire in place by rotating it counterclockwise.
- Using pliers or tweezers, remove the connectors attached to the white and black wires.

## Step 4



- Using a screwdriver, pull the cord string relief out of the mixer by putting it behind the cord and pulling away from the mixer until it is free.
- Remove the cord from the mixer body.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
