## **INTRODUCTION**

If your device is not turning on it could be because of worn down carbon brushes. Here is a guide to replace these brushes.



# **TOOLS:**

• Flathead Screwdriver (1)

## Step 1 — Carbon Brushes





- Using a flat head screwdriver, unscrew the brush cap on each side of the mixer by turning them counter clockwise.
- Remove brush cap by pulling it toward you.
- The brushes are held in by springs and will fly out if removed too fast.

# Step 2



- Remove brush by pulling it toward you.
- One corner of the brush is flattened. You can check which way the brush is oriented by shining a flashlight inside the hole.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
