INTRODUCTION

Keeping the back panel in good condition is key to extending the lifetime of the camera.



TOOLS:

- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Back Panel



- Power down the camera and remove the batteries.

Step 2



- Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver, remove all of the screws from the back panel casing.

i There are six 5.22mm long, 3.00mm head diameter screws total.

i The left side is not shown but there should be 1 screw on that side.

Step 3



- Remove the back casing.
- ⓘ The casing itself is sturdy so don't be afraid to remove it forcefully.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
