

INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will show you how to remove and replace the Display Assembly.



TOOLS:


Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Disconnecting the Mini-Card Antenna Cables




- Follow the instructions in Begin.
- Disconnect the Mini-Card antenna cables from the Mini-Card(s).

Step 2 — **Dislodging the Mini-Card Antenna Cables**




 Make note of the cable routing and carefully dislodge the Mini-Card antenna cables from the routing guides.

Step 3 — Disconnecting the Display Cable




 Disconnect the display cable from the system board connector.

Step 4 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the two screws (one on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

Step 5 — Removing the Display Assembly




 Lift and remove the display assembly off the computer base.

Step 6 — Placing the Display Assembly




 Place the **NEW** display assembly in position and replace the two screws (one on each side) that secure the display assembly to the computer base.

Step 7 — Connecting the Display Cable




 Connect the display cable to the system board connector.

Step 8 — Routing the Mini-Card Cables



 Route the Mini-Card antenna cables through the routing guides on the computer base.

Step 9 — Conencting the Mini-Card Antenna Cables



 Connect the Mini-Card antenna cables to the Mini-Card(s).

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
