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INTRODUCTION

In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.

TOOLS:

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• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Disconnecting the Hard-Drive Assembly



- WARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in <u>"Before You Begin".</u>
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- CAUTION: Hard drives are extremely fragile. Exercise care when handling the hard drive.
- Slide the hard-drive assembly to the left to disconnect it from the connector on the system board.

Step 2 — Lifting the Hard-Drive Assembly




• Lift the hard-drive assembly out of the computer base.

Step 3 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the two screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 4 — Placing the Hard Drive




• Place the hard-drive bracket on the **NEW** hard drive.



Step 5 — Replace the Two Screws

 Replace the two screws that secure the hard-drive bracket to the hard drive.

Step 6 — Placing the Hard Drive Assembly



• Place the hard-drive assembly on the computer base.

Step 7 — Pushing the Hard-Drive Assembly



 Push the hard-drive assembly towards the right to connect it to the connector on the system board.
