# INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will show you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.



# **TOOLS:**


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in Before You Begin.
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- Remove the two screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.

#### Step 2 — Sliding the Assembly




 Slide the hard-drive assembly out of the hard-drive compartment.

### Step 3 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the two screws that secure the hard-drive bezel to the hard drive.

## Step 4 — Removing the Hard Drive




 Pull the hard-drive bezel away from the hard drive.

### **Step 5** — Align the Screw Holes




 Align the screw holes on the NEW hard-drive bezel with the screw holes on the hard drive and replace the two screws.

#### **Step 6** — **Sliding the Hard-Drive Assembly**



 Slide the hard-drive assembly into the hard-drive compartment until it is fully seated.

## **Step 7** — Replace the Screws



 Replace the two screws that secure the hard-drive assembly to the computer base.
