This guide will show the steps of removing a damaged keyboard key from your laptop. The keyboard is an input device; you can enter any characters and functions by pressing keyboard keys.



TOOLS:

• iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — **Damaged keyboard key**



Slide under the key using a flat object and pop it out of place.

Using metal to open fragile parts of a laptop could cause damage! Instead use the blue opening tool listed in the tool section above.

Step 2



The key is now out of place.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
