

INTRODUCTION


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.



TOOLS:


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the instructions in Before You Begin.
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- Remove the two screws that secure the hard drive to the base of the computer.

Step 2 — Sliding the Hard Drive




 Slide the hard drive away from the hard-drive connector on the system board.

Step 3 — Lifting the Hard Drive




 Lift the hard drive out of the harddrive bay.

Step 4 — Placing the Hard Drive



 Place the **NEW** hard drive in the hard-drive bay and push the hard drive towards the connector until it is fully seated.

Step 5 — Replace the Screws



 Turn the computer over and replace the two screws that secure the harddrive to the base of the computer.
