

## **INTRODUCTION**


In this guide, we will be showing you how to remove and replace the Hard Drive.



## **TOOLS:**


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Remove the Screws




- MARNING: Before working inside your computer, read the safety information that shipped with your computer. Follow the procedures in Before You Begin.
- CAUTION: To avoid electrostatic discharge, ground yourself by using a wrist grounding strap or by periodically touching an unpainted metal surface (such as a connector on your computer).
- Remove the two screws that secure the hard drive assembly to the computer base.

#### Step 2 — Sliding the Hard Drive Assembly




 Slide the hard drive assembly out of the hard drive compartment.


## Step 3 — Remove the Screws



 Remove the two screws that secure the hard drive bezel to the hard drive.


## Step 4 — Lifting the Hard Drive






Lift the hard drive bezel off the hard drive.

## Step 5 — Align the Screw Holes




 Align the screw holes on the hard drive bezel with the holes on the NEW hard drive.

#### Step 6 — Replace the Screws




 Replace the two screws that secure the hard drive bezel to the hard drive.

## **Step 7** — **Sliding the Hard Drive Assembly**



 Slide the hard drive assembly into the hard drive compartment until it is fully seated.

#### Step 8 — Replace the Screws



 Replace the two screws that secure the hard drive assembly to the computer base.
