## INTRODUCTION

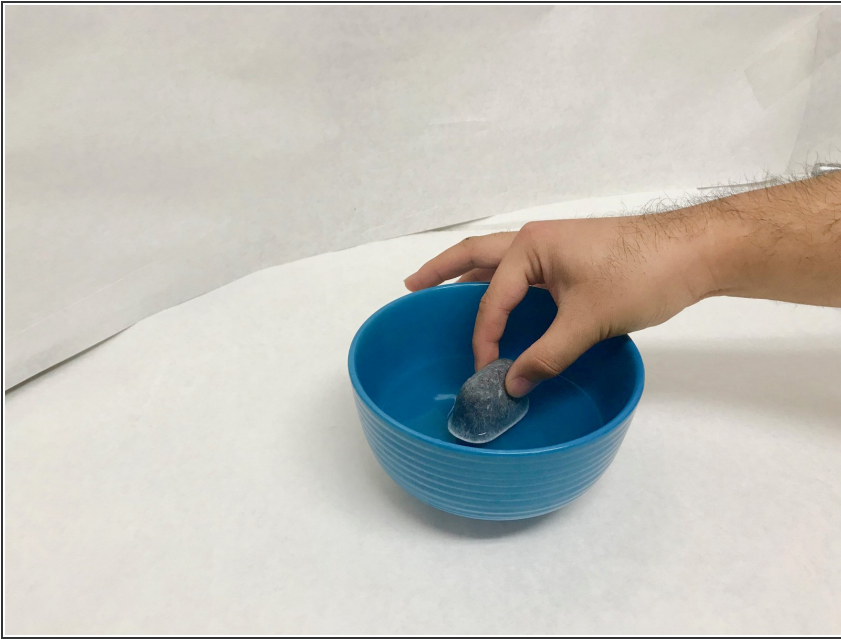
Replacing a Keurig water filter will help your machine run smoother. This also helps improve the quality of brews.

## Step 1 — Charcoal water filter



- Soak the new charcoal filter in water for 5 minutes.

## Step 2



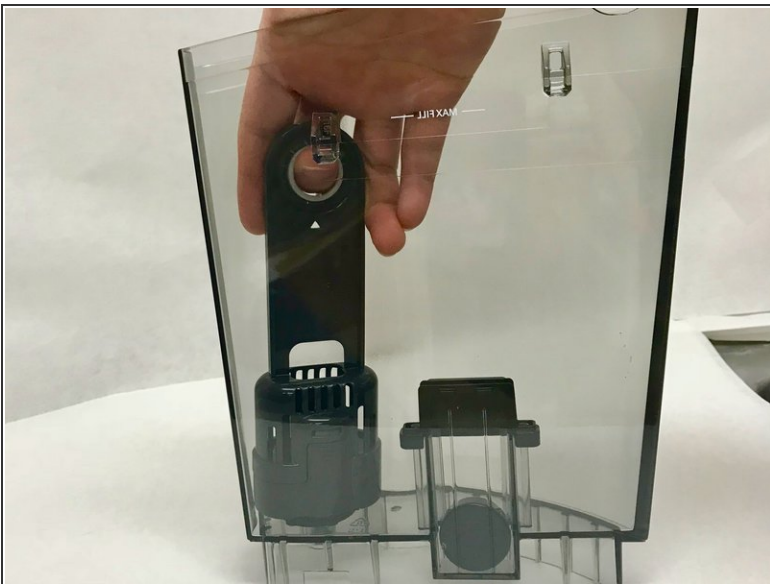
- Remove the water reservoir from the Keurig machine by gently lifting up on the reservoir and pulling it away.

### Step 3



- Remove the lid from the water reservoir and empty any remaining water from the tank.

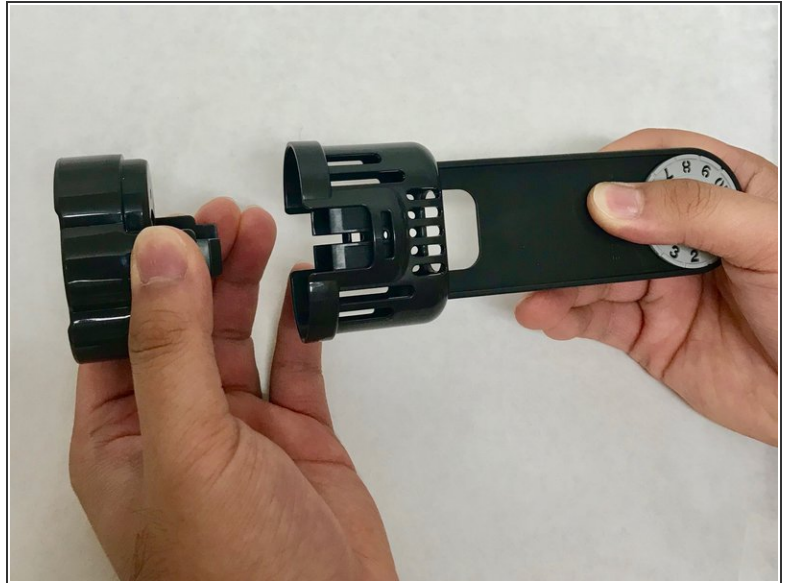
### Step 4



- Remove water filter holder from within the water reservoir by pulling up on the holder and lifting it out.



## Step 5



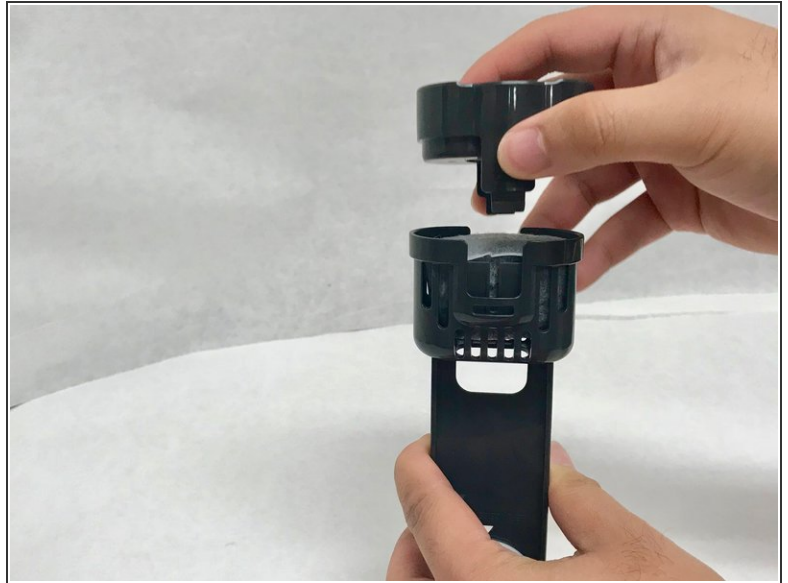
- To remove the old filter, pinch both sides of the filter holder at the base and pull it apart. Remove the old filter by lifting it out of the filter holder.
- Dispose of old water filter cartridge.

## Step 6



- Take the soaked water filter and rinse it under running water for 60 seconds.

## Step 7



- Place new water filter cartridge into the upper filter holder.
- Snap the bottom of the filter holder back on by aligning the tabs with the spaces

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
