# INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to remove the Moto E4 motherboard cover. Doing so allows access to the front facing camera, the rear facing camera, and the motherboard.

## Step 1 — Remove the rear cover



 Before removing the battery, power off your Moto E4.

- Remove the plastic cover by gently prying it up from the notch at the bottom right corner of the phone.
- With the phone face down, lift the battery up by the labeled tab and remove it from the device.

## Step 2 — Motherboard Cover



- Remove all nine 4mm screws from the top plastic cover with a Phillips driver.

## Step 3



- Gently pry up the plastic cover from the gap between it and the phone edge.
  - Start on the right side as indicated by the first picture.
  - Continue prying around the rest of the cover in a counter clockwise path.
- Once loose, remove the plastic cover from the phone.
