


Asus VivoBook X202E-DB21T Trackpad Replacement

How to replace the trackpad on your Asus VivoBook X202E-DB21T.

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INTRODUCTION

The trackpad is used to track mouse movements based on finger movements on the pad. This can get damaged easily due to liquid damage, overuse, or dropping the device.



TOOLS:

- Phillips Head Screwdriver: Size PH1 (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- Flip the device such that the labels are on top.
- Use a Phillips #1 screwdriver to remove the four 8mm screws near the back.
- Use the same screwdriver to remove the four 5mm screws in the front.
- Use the same screwdriver to remove the single 9mm screw in the center.
- Make sure that the device is powered down and unplugged.


Step 2





Remove the back cover by gently prying with a spudger.


Step 3





- Remove the eight 5mm screws using a Phillips #1 screwdriver.
- ♠ Do not puncture the battery.

Step 4




 Disconnect the battery ribbon cable from the motherboard.


Step 5



Remove the battery from the laptop.


Step 6 — Trackpad






Remove the ten 4mm screws using a Phillips #00.

Step 7




 Carefully remove the metal plate from the laptop.

Step 8



 Remove the four 5mm screws from the trackpad using a Phillips #00.

Step 9



Remove the trackpad from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
