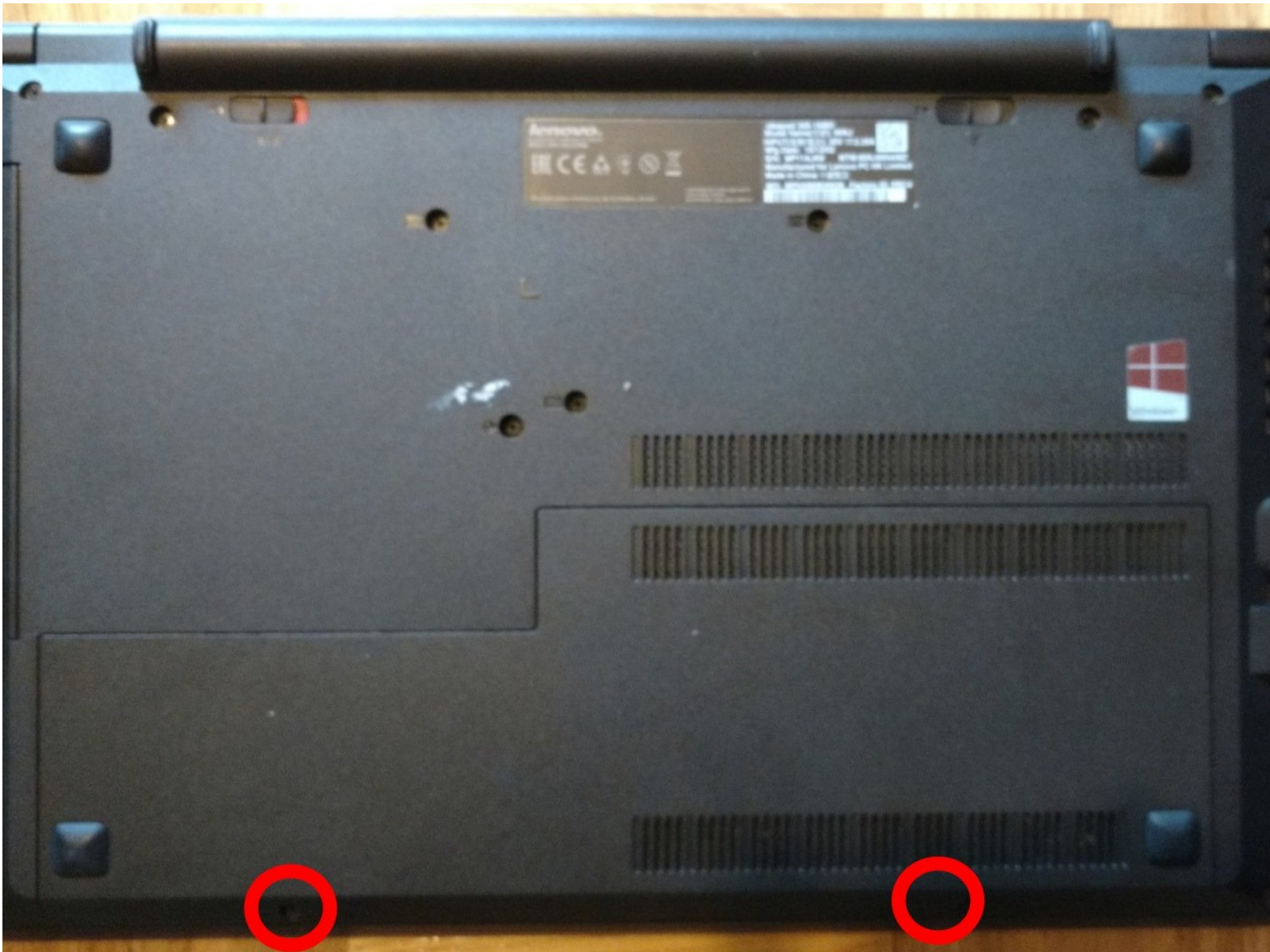

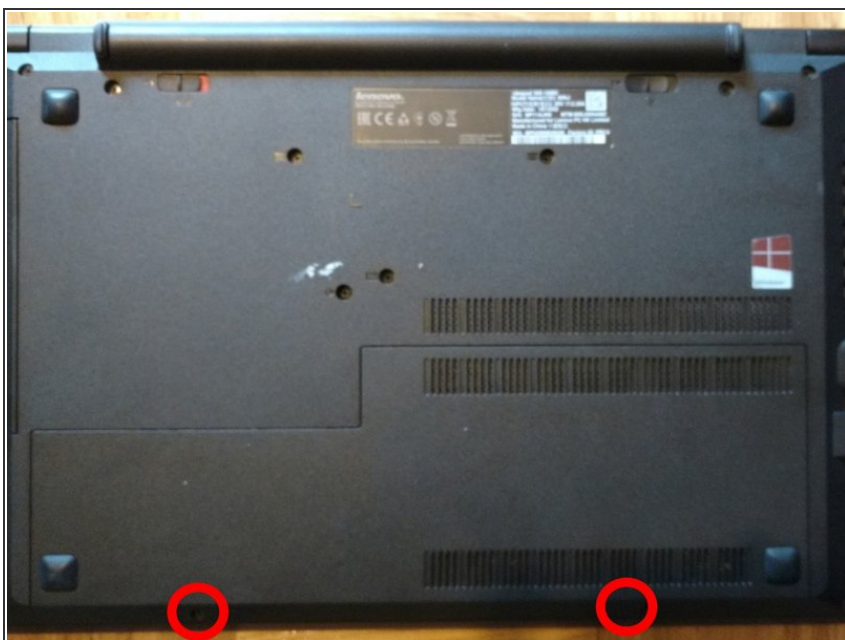

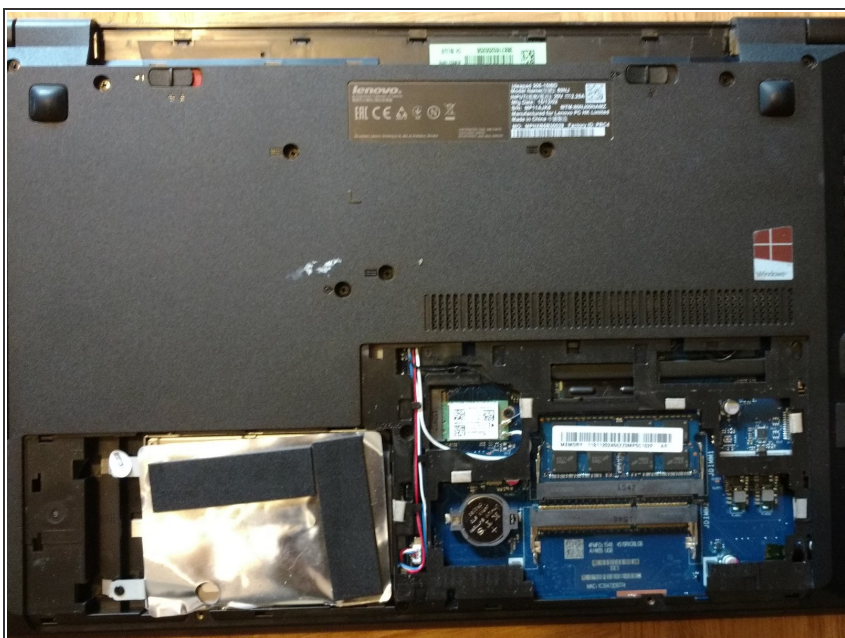

- Remove the two screws at the back bottom.

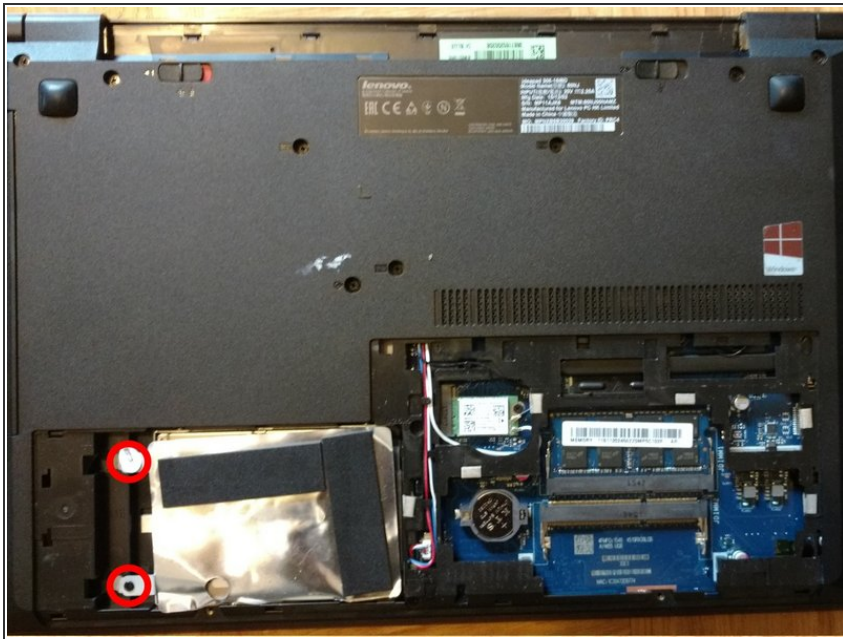
## Step 2



- Remove the back cover by sliding it out.

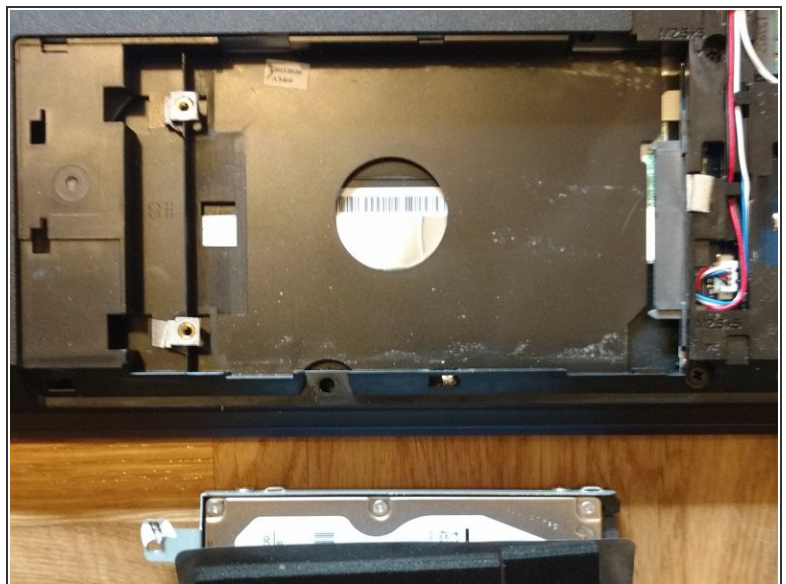


## Step 3

- Disconnect the harddrive connector by sliding it left. Then remove it.
