Step 1 — Windshield Wiper




- Lift the windshield wiper to a 90-degree angle above the windshield.

Step 2




- Tilt the wiper upwards.
 - Pull the wiper blade down to release it from the j-hook.
- i** Different brands of wipers use different unlatching mechanisms; these vary from pinching and pulling to pushing a button.

Step 3



- Lay the arm back down onto the windshield.

 Place the arm gently back down to avoid any damage.

Step 4




- Remove the plastic protection from the rubber side of the new wiper blades.

Step 5



- Lift the wiper arm back up and latch the j-hook around the mounting point of the new blade.

Step 6



- Gently lay the wipers back down onto windshield.

Step 7



- Start your vehicle.
 - Turn on the windshield wipers to ensure they are functioning properly.
- ⚠ Do not turn the engine on in a closed space to prevent carbon monoxide poisoning.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
