## Step 1 — Vacuum Belt



- Place the vacuum at an angle most comfortable and easy to access with the bottom facing upwards.

## Step 2



- Remove the three screws holding the base plate to the body of the vacuum using a flat head screwdriver.
- Place the plate to the side.

### Step 3



- Simply slide the roller out of the vacuum.
- ⓘ The belt is attached to the roller on either side.

### Step 4



- Slide the vacuum belt out from beneath the wheel holding it in place.



## Step 5



- Insert your new belt and pop the roller back into place.

## Step 6



- Secure the plate once again until it clicks into the made grooves.
- Secure the three screws until tightened.

Make sure to test the vacuum and securely tighten all screws. With that, you're good to go!
