
This guide will show you how to remove the laptop RAM.

• Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)


Step 1 — RAM



- Place the laptop on a fat surface with the underside facing up
- Remove the 4 Philips head screws.
- Turn the computer over and open the display
- Grasping each side of the palm rest, gently lift it off and rotate toward the front of the laptop

The palm rest will be connected to the main board by a ribbon cable

Step 2



- Disconnect the touchpad ribbon cable
- This step is recommended in the service manual however it is possible to remove the RAM without discoinnecting the touchpad cable

Step 3



- Locate the RAM modules
- Gently press the metal tabs outwards to release the top RAM module and remove it from the laptop
- With the top RAM module removed you can release the lower RAM module in the same manner.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
