INTRODUCTION

Replace faulty sticks of RAM

PARTS:


- 8GB OWC Memory Upgrade Kit (1)
- 16GB OWC Memory Upgrade Kit (1)
- 32GB OWC Memory Upgrade Kit (8 core only) (1)

Step 1 — Remove the side panel




- Lift the latch at the back of the computer
- Lift the side panel

Step 2 — Remove the Processor Board




- Press both latches to unlock the bracket and then pull it towards you
- Press where you see the circles
- A You shouldn't need to apply much force.

Step 3 — Remove the old RAM



- Push the RAM tabs down to release the RAM
- (i) When reinstalling the RAM it will take some force to install it properly!
- (i) Repeat this step for each stick of RAM you want to replace.
