


# **Ricoh YF-20 Super Lens Cover Replacement**

## **INTRODUCTION**

This process involves removing the back cover, the front cover, and the zoom mechanism of the camera. After, the lens cover can be removed from the front cover.

# TOOLS:

Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

### Step 1 — Front Cover




• Use the screwdriver to unscrew the indicated screws from the left, right, bottom, and back sides of the camera.



• Loosen the back cover from both the left and the right sides of the camera. Take off the back cover.

A The lid of the battery compartment may fall off because it is not attached to anything.


# Step 3



- Open the film compartment.
- Press your finger on top of the grey latch on the left side of the camera.



- (i) Removing the film compartment door is optional. However, it may aid maneuverability in future steps.
- Use a thin object like a toothpick or a small screwdriver to push down on the metal pin holding the film compartment door in place.
- Use your fingers to completely remove the metal pin.
- Remove the film compartment door.




# Step 5

• Use a thin shaft screwdriver and unscrew the two indicated screws within the film compartment.



- Loosen the front cover from the left and right sides of the camera.
- Take off the front cover.

#### Step 7 — Lens Cover



- The lens cover is only attached to the front cover of the camera. Set the rest of the camera aside.
- In order to reach the lens cover, the zoom mechanism must be removed.
- Unscrew three screws from the front cover that hold the zoom mechanism in place.
- Remove the zoom mechanism.



- Unscrew the five screws that hold the lens cover plate and metal brace in place.
- Remove metal brace.
- Remove lens cover plate.

### Step 9



- To remove lens cover, push the lens cover from the outside of the front cover towards the inside of the front cover.
- Remove the lens cover.

 $\triangle$  The metal arm attached to the lens cover is not securely attached and may fall off.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
