

# Nikon D70 Front Cover Replacement

#### **INTRODUCTION**

## **TOOLS:**

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #00 Screwdriver (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)

#### Step 1 — Front Cover



 Use a plastic opening tool to carefully pry up the flash unit at the point shown in the picture.

## Step 2



 Remove the two 4.3 mm Phillips screws securing the top edge of the front cover to the top cover.

## Step 3



 Remove the two 4.3 mm Phillips screws on the face of the front cover.

#### Step 4



 Use the sharp end of a metal spudger or a razor blade to peel the sticker out of the center of the automatic/manual focus switch.

#### Step 5





- Remove the 6.3 mm shouldered Phillips screw from the center of the automatic/manual focus switch.
- Pull the automatic/manual focus switch away from the front cover.

## Step 6



if present, remove the plastic cover from the lens mount.

## Step 7



 Pull the front cover away from the D70.
