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Step 1 — CMOS / BIOS Battery replacement



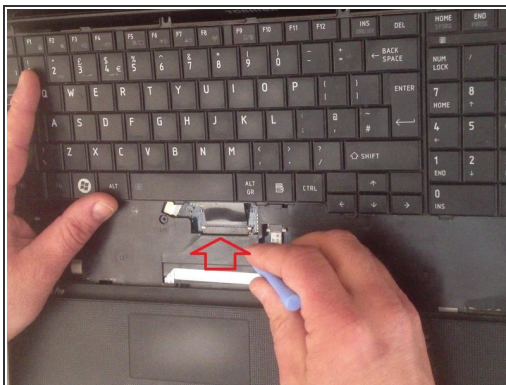
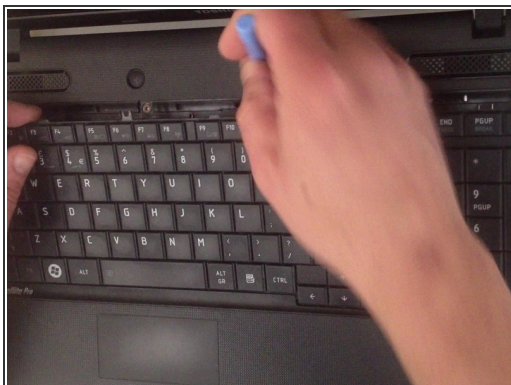
- Disconnect the charger and the battery.

Step 2



- Remove the narrow plastic lid and unscrew 4x Phillips screw.

Step 3



- Remove the keyboard.

Step 4



- This is the internal CMOS / BIOS battery. Use small screwdriver to remove it.

Step 5



- And that's it!
