INTRODUCTION

This guide will illustrate how to replace the batteries in a Game Boy system.

PARTS:AA alkaline batteries (4)

Step 1 — Batteries



• Switch your Game Boy off and remove the cartridge.

Step 2



- Use a fingernail (or small coin) to push down on the battery door latch and remove the battery door.
 - (i) The release latch is a plastic spring clip. If your Game Boy is getting on in years, be careful as the plastic may be brittle.
 - When you're replacing the cover, be sure to get its two plastic tabs into the slots in the bottom of the battery compartment before pushing the cover back in place.

Step 3



Use a fingernail to pry each battery outward from the positive (+) terminal to remove them.

 Dispose of used batteries properly!

(i) Remove the batteries from your Game Boy before storing it for more than a month or so.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
