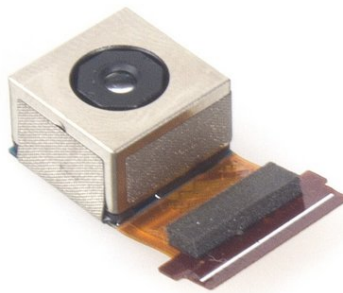

INTRODUCTION

Before you begin, download the [Rescue and Smart Assistant](#) app to backup your device and diagnose whether your problem is software or hardware related.

TOOLS:

Step 1 — Rear Camera



- Remove SIM card tray.

Step 2



- Push the eject pin to open a gap and place a guitar pick into the gap.

Step 3



- Slide the guitar pick to cut the adhesive sticker and peel off the back cover.

Step 4



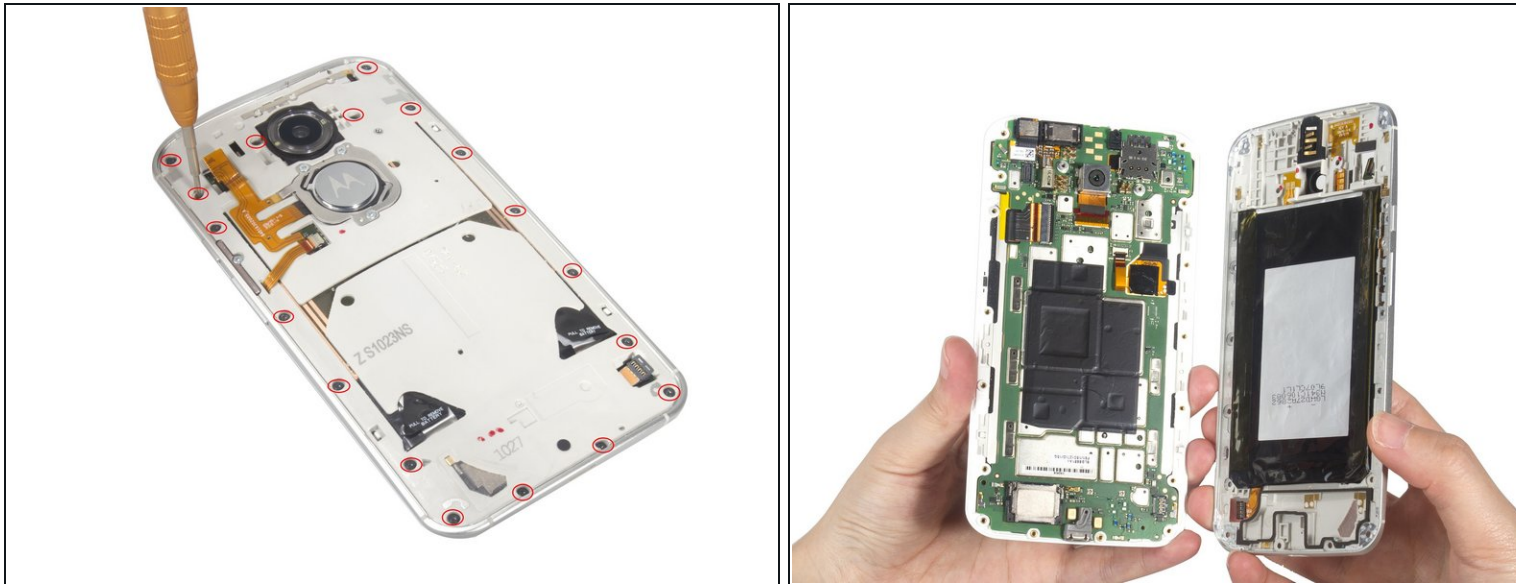
- Remove two pieces rubber cover which protecting the flex connectors.

Step 5



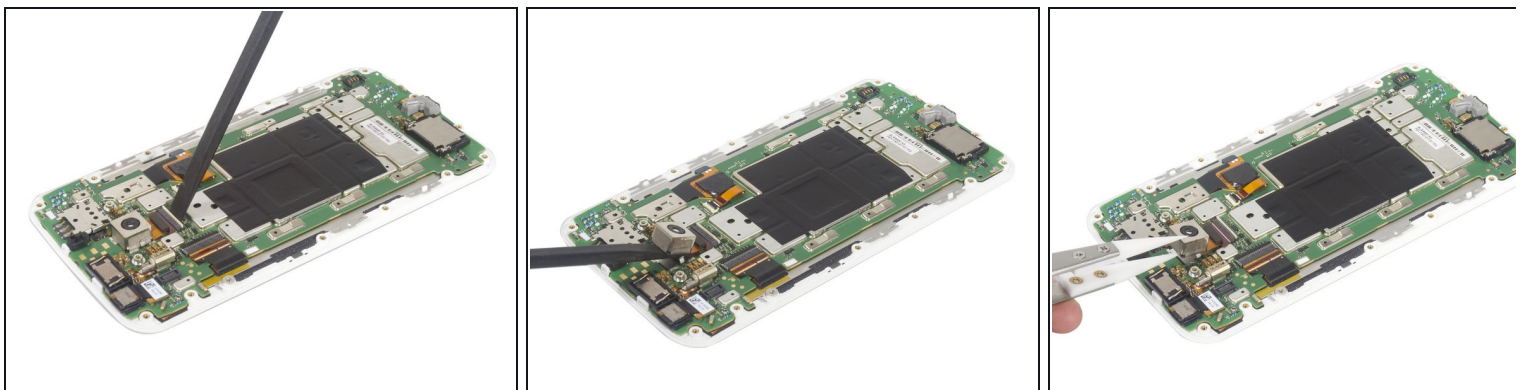
- Release the power button connecting flex connector and battery connector carefully.

Step 6



- Twist off all 18 black torx screws and separate the middle housing from front assembly.

Step 7



- Release rear camera connector and remove it easily.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
