## Step 1 — Lower Case



- Before proceeding, close your computer and lay it on a soft surface top-side down.
  - Remove the following ten screws:
    - Two 8 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
    - Eight 2.5 mm 5-point Pentalobe screws
- *(i)* The special screwdriver needed to remove the eight 5-point Pentalobe screws can be found <u>here</u>.

## Step 2



- Wedge your fingers between the display and the lower case and pull upward to pop the lower case off the Air.
- Remove the lower case and set it aside.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
