


# LG K10 Earphone jack Replacement




# INTRODUCTION

This repair guide will teach you how to replace the 3.5 mm auxiliary jack in an LG K10.



## Step 1 — Earphone jack




- Power off the device.
- Remove the back lining

## Step 2




• Remove the battery

#### Step 3



 Unscrew every screw of the bottom of the phone and use guitar picks to remove the plastic frame of the phone

## Step 4




With tweezers remove the headphone jack piece on the motherboard, and insert the new piece in the position of the old one.

#### Step 5



• Screw in the bottom case.

## Step 6



• Insert the battery and back case.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
